This cute piece will be taught by Judy Gibson!

It is painted on a tavern sign board. The overall size is 12" x 21.5" x 3/4". The inside painting surface is 12" x 14".

The wood for this project is available at JB Wood Products, Item number 90094, or you may have something in your stash. You do not need to purchase the stencil for the wording as Judy has included the lettering on the line drawing.



The surface is prepped with Black Slate Chalkboard Paint and requires 24-hour curing before you can paint the pattern on it.

The fee for this paint-in is \$15.00.

This comes as a kit with a base plaque (approximately 14" x 8"); a pumpkin (8" x 4") and a package of gears. All you need to add is your time, talent and paint!!
